

Advertising Retraction By Rubber Polymer Corporation

In the past, Rubber Polymer Corporation and its employees have incorrectly stated that asphalt based products such as TUFF-N-DRI® contain leachable chemicals which can contaminate the groundwater. A brochure published by Rubber Polymer Corporation claimed that RUB-R-WALL® is safer and superior to TUFF-N-DRI® in terms of leachability and toxicity based upon "tests" showing samples of TUFF-N-DRI® and RUB-R-WALL® immersed in side-by-side beakers of near boiling water. The test reflected in that brochure is inaccurate and does not support the claim that TUFF-N-DRI® contains leachable chemicals which can contaminate the groundwater. TUFF-N-DRI® is an asphalt based product modified by the addition of polymer and does not exhibit leachability. Rubber Polymer Corporation will cease and desist from making such claims in connection with any advertisement or promotion of its products. This retraction is being issued in compliance with a Consent Judgment Order entered in the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio Eastern Division in Tremco Barrier Solutions, Inc. v. Rubber Polymer Corporation, Case Number 5:04 CV 00207 which Consent Judgment Order has been ordered into effect by the Honorable James S. Gwin, a United States District Judge.
